Only Yes Means Yes!

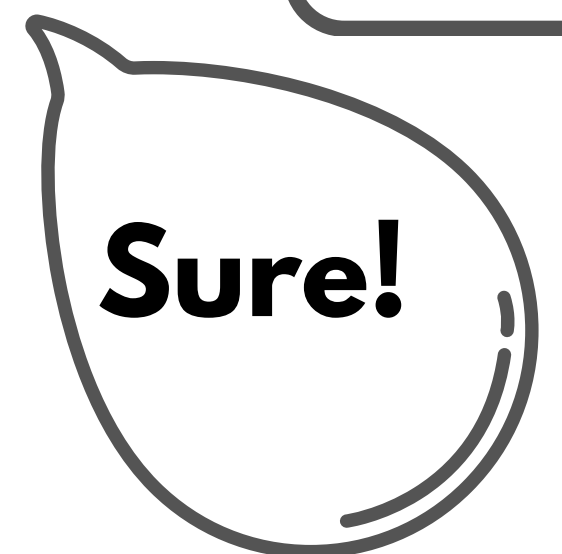
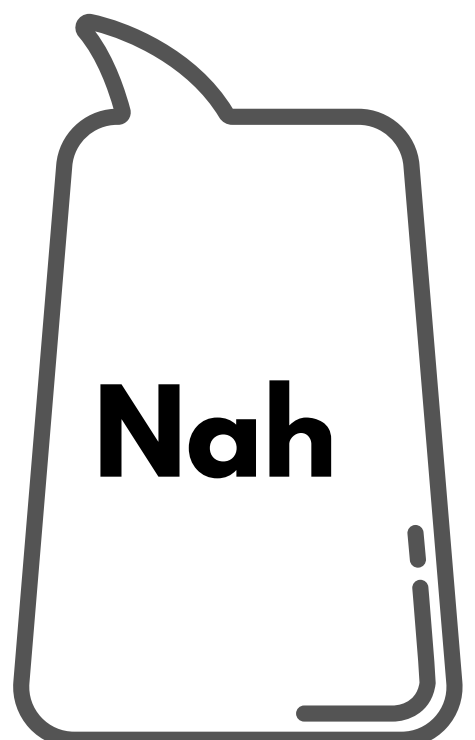
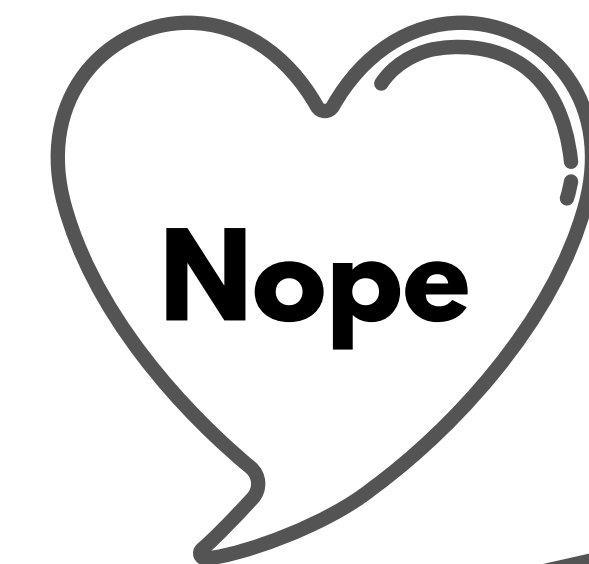
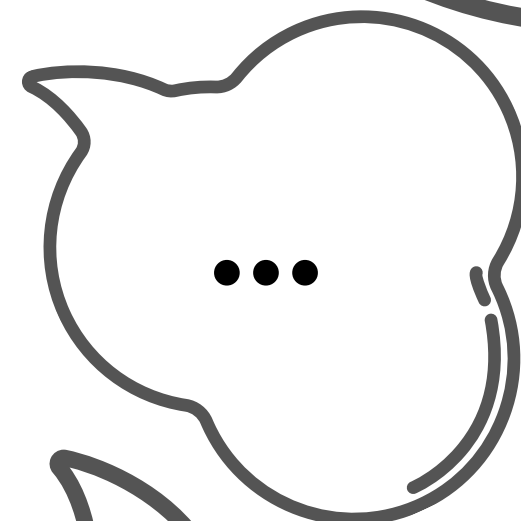
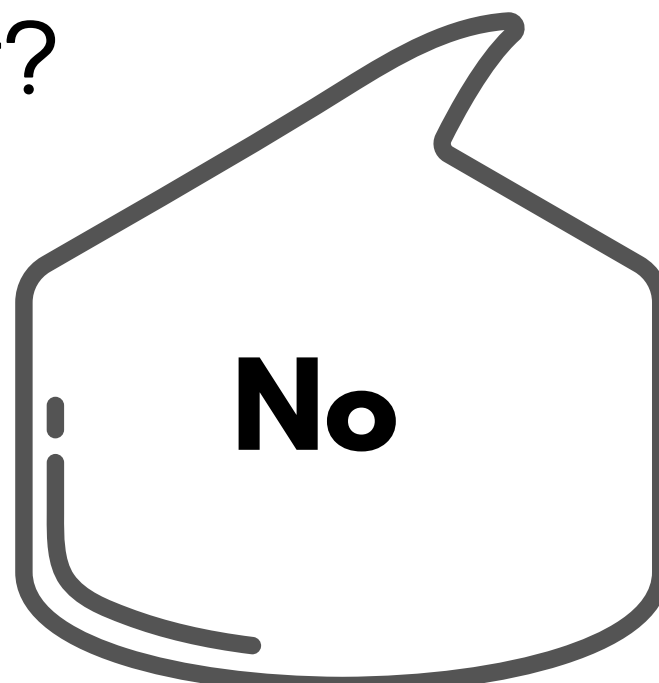
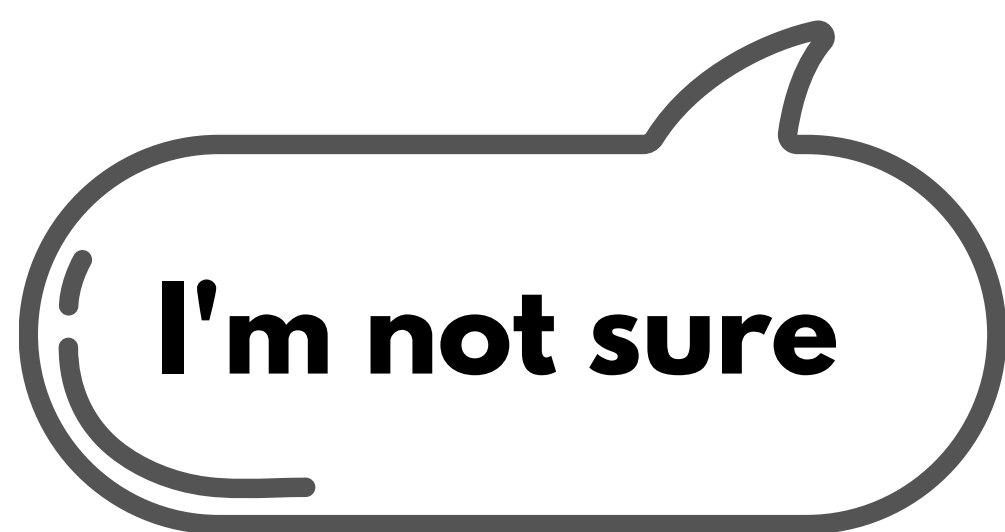
Before touching, kissing, or any kind of sex, ask if it is ok and respect what they say.

What Can Consent Sound Like?

- Hey, I really like you, can I kiss you?
- You don't seem really into this, let's stop.
- Do you want to try something sexy with me?
- Can you touch me here?
- What feels good for you?
- Is everything okay?
- Do you wanna...?



SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Unwanted sexual touching or sexual attention is sexual violence

If someone tells us No respect it.

Pressuring someone to do something they don't want is sexual coercion, a type of sexual violence.

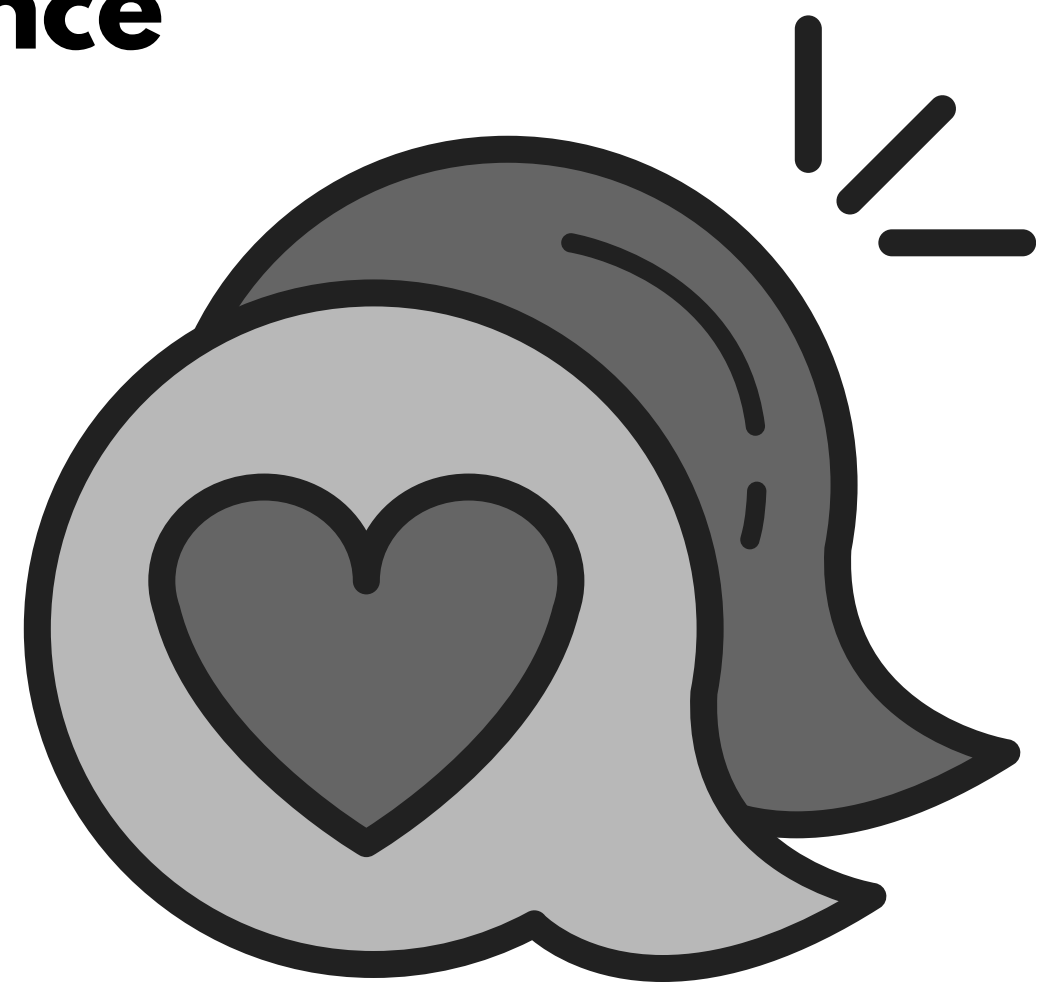
If You've Experienced Sexual Violence
